



## THE WOMAN'S CENTURY CLUB

The Woman's Century Club was organized in 1891 by Carrie Chapman Catt. When Susan B. Anthony retired, Mrs. Catt took her place as president of the Suffrage Movement. She traveled extensively, came west, and organized The Woman's Century Club believing that the next century was to be "a Woman's Century."

The Woman's Century Club helped start the Martha Washington School for Girls; paid the salary of the first librarian for a year; started Travelers Aid and paid half the salaries for its workers for two years.

A \$1000.00 Scholarship will be awarded to a woman whose programs or classes make a worthwhile addition to the quality of life.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

All applicants must: Be a Citizen of the United States and an undergraduate student with Junior standings.

1. Be a woman currently attending a fully accredited school of higher education in the State of Washington.
2. Submit completed application and related materials required.
3. Be in need of financial assistance.
4. Have a demonstrated high scholastic ability.
5. Submit an official transcript of most recent grades.
6. Be continuing an educational program in one of the following fields: Fine Arts; Music; Medicine or Nursing; Woman's studies.

### SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS (\$1,000.00 minimum):

[Awarded annually in three equal installment and sent to the recipient's educational institution]  
Offered to a woman student seeking continuing education in one of the fields identified in #6 above.

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- I. The completed application and all related material must be sent to The Woman's Century Club Scholarship Committee at the address listed on the Instructions (page 2 of 6) **BY THE DEADLINE**. Late applications and/or facsimiles will not be accepted.
- II. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications. Selection of a winner will be made in accordance with requirements established solely by The Woman's Century Club Scholarship Committee.
- III. The Woman's Century Club Scholarship Committee reserves the right to reject any or all applications.
- IV. The Scholarship Committee, upon selection of the recipient, will voucher and authorize The Woman's Century Club Treasurer to issue a scholarship check [in equal installments for three quarters] to the educational institution until the full dollar amount of the scholarship has been paid. The scholarship can be applied to tuition, books, lab fees, and appropriate supplies to the course of study.
- V. The recipient will be notified by mail. The winner will be invited to attend a future meeting of The Woman's Century Club. All expenses, exclusive of the cost of a meal, will be borne by the recipient. Upon request, the winner will submit a recent black and white photo to the committee for publicity purposes.
